Lesson 11 - Rewards and Chastisement

A reward is what is given for obedience. Chastisement is what is given for disobedience.

What Rewards Are

The New Testament word *reward* means a *salary* or *wage* or *that which is earned*. Salvation is given freely by the grace of God and is not a reward. When we are obedient to the Lord and serve Him, He *pays* us for that service. We do not yet understand exactly what *rewards* will be, but we know that they will be far better than silver and gold. Jesus calls them *treasures in heaven*. After you are saved, if you work for Him, you will receive a reward. If you do not work, you will still be saved, but you will have no reward.
