Lesson 13 - God's Plan for Giving

Money is not the important thing in serving God, obedience is. However, it is impossible to carry on God's work without money. It takes money to send missionaries and to pay bills. From the beginning it has been God's plan for God's people to give to carry on His work. Abraham gave tithes (*Tithe* means *ten percent*). Under the Law of M oses, Israel was required to give tithes. In the New Testament we still have a responsibility to carry on God's work with our money.

Giving is Investing with God.

When we give our money at church to carry on the work, we are not giving it away, but investing it. We are promised blessings here on earth and rewards in heaven.
