

# BASIC BIBLE COURSE

## Lesson 9 - Pastors and Deacons

There are two offices in a New Testament church, pastors and deacons. There were three different names used in the New Testament to describe the office we call pastor. They were *elder*, *bishop* and *pastor*.

### The Elder

In the New Testament the actual name for the office is *elder*. The term *elder* signifies maturity and the wisdom, knowledge and experience that goes with maturity. The elders were to be held in high esteem by the people.

### Elders were ordained in every church.

#### Acts 14:23:

### The Bishop

The word *bishop* describes the work of an elder. *Bishop* means *overseer* or *superintendent*. The pastor is the *overseer* of the church. In the New Testament a bishop was never overseer of more than one church.

### A bishop was one of the offices of a church.

## The Pastor

**Pastor** is the word we use most often today to designate the New Testament office of **elder**. Pastor is a descriptive word that simply means **shepherd**. As a shepherd watches over his flock, leads it, feeds it and protects it, so a pastor is to do to the flock that the Holy Spirit has placed in his care.

## The pastor is to feed the flock.

### 1 Peter 5:2:

## Deacons

The word **deacon** means **servant**. The deacons were first placed in the church at Jerusalem in

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Acts 6. They were elected by the church to take care of a material problem that had arisen in the church so that the Apostles would not have to leave studying the Word and praying. Deacons today serve the same purpose. They are elected by the church and placed over a material problem so that the pastor can give himself to studying the Word and praying.

**Deacon was one of the New Testament offices.**

**Philippians 1:1:**
